Treasurer, Judy Brown provided the 2025 Year End Treasurer's Report showing a balance of \$7,504.40 (after payment of the Fine Art Show expenses in December). The report was unanimously approved by the members. Judy reported that the 2025 Fine Art Show net profit was \$913.

Secretary, Paulette Baker previously posted the November 2025 Meeting Minutes on the website. These minutes were unanimously approved by the members.

1<sup>st</sup> VP, Pat Saez provided information about the upcoming Paint 'N Sip event and the watercolor workshop with Georgia Lawson. (Both events were filled by the end of the January meeting)

President, Steve Brenner made announcements:

- Membership Dues are due this month.
- The board has voted on several items concerning the Fine Art Show:
  - Purchase ten (10) new easels for the art show, to eliminate the need for hanging art very close to the floor.
  - Increase the refreshments budget to \$250 for the Fine Art Show, to enhance the food choices at the show
  - Hang all beginner entries from all categories, together at the Fine Art Show
  - Propose a revision to the Operating Procedures to eliminate the déjà vu category, since there are very few entries in that category. Members will be asked to vote at the February meeting.
- The dates of the Fine Art Show will be November 6 (drop off) 7-8 (the show) in 2026.
- The Art Wall at Desert Vista will feature art by Stephanie Windsong in January, and Michael Christensen in February.
- There will be an Art Show Committees orientation on April 20<sup>th</sup>, at 2:30PM, immediately following the membership meeting, to review rules, processes, and expectations for members who participate as voluntary staff at the Fall Fine Art Show.
- Our next meeting will be in February

Educational Program: Artist Georgia Lawson provided a demo and described her process for color choices and for painting eyes.
